(59) TEMPORARY APPOINTMENT OF RATE COLLECTOR FOR NO. 2 COLLECTION DISTRICT:

On the recommendation of the Secretary, it was proposed by Councillor Thomas Byrne, seconded by Councillor Patrick Byrne and unanimously resolved that Mr. J. J. A. Masterson, Rate Inspector, be temporarily appointed as Rate Collector for No. 2 Collection District pending sanction to the Council's proposal to transfer Mr. Curtis to that district.
