

WEXFORD COUNTY COUNCIL

Meeting of New Ross District Committee  
held in the Engineers Office, New Ross  
on Friday 17th December 1965 at 7 p.m.

ATTENDANCE:

MINUTES:

The Minutes of the Meeting held on the 25th August 1965 were adopted on the proposal of Councillor Minihan and seconded by Councillor Furlong.

DEPUTATION:

A deputation comprising Miss Doyle, Mrs. Cullen and Miss Scully attended in connection with the matter dealt with in the Official Record.

ENGINEERS REPORTS:

The reports of Missrs Quinn, Ward and Finnegan were read and adopted.

COUNTY ROAD RECONSTRUCTION 1966/'67:

The Committee agreed that first priority be given to second surface dressing on roads which had already been reconstructed (under loan or grant) and have received only one sealing coat. In addition priority is to be given to completion of schemes already selected or commenced under 1965/'66 loan Programme if loan finance is not made available.

Subject to above the following Priority list for County Road Reconstruction was adopted for the year 1966/'67 subject to continuence of existing grants and loans.

ROADS:

Scullabogue Cross to Main New Ross - Wexford Road.

It was agreed that this stretch of road should not be abandoned and that it be listed for consideration at the next General Purpose Meeting. The alignment of the road would have to be rearranged.

COTTAGE REPAIR PRIORITY LIST:

Draft lists for Mr. Quinn's and Mr. Ward's areas were submitted. It is decided that Councillors would take the draft lists away and study them and write in to the County Engineer if it was felt that any other cottage should be added. The matter will then be re-submitted to the next meeting. Mr. Finnegan, A.C.E. did not submit a list as there were only a few cottages in his area requiring repairs.

ADDITIONAL RURAL PUBLIC LIGHTING:

It was decided to adjourn this matter to find out the Annual cost of electricity for each light.



PUBLIC LIGHTING FOR MAIN ROADS:

The meeting was informed that £250 was available for the provision of lights on Main and Arterial roads subject to sanction.

The meeting agreed to provide this lighting on the main roads through New Ross, the terminable points to be discussed with the Engineer. The question of additional annual charges would be discussed with New Ross Urban Council.

PUBLIC LIGHTING BALLYHACK PIER:

The meeting was informed that there were five lights at Ballyhack Pier operating from "dusk to midnight". It was agreed to alter two of these lights in order to have them operating from "dusk to dawn" and to consult with the fishermen regarding which lights should be adjusted.

Proceedings then terminated. (Recommendation with regard to the particular cases under the various headings are detailed in the Schedule to the official records).

DEPUTATION

The members of the deputation pointed out that under the proposed Parking regulations for New Ross, no parking would be permitted in John Street or Bridge Street. This would bring ruin to the shopkeepers in these streets and the members urged that one side parking be permitted. The Committee was informed that the County Council was not concerned as it was a matter for the Gardai and New Ross Urban Council. It was agreed to ask the Council to recommend an amendment in the Parking regulations to provide one side parking with limitations in John Street and Bridge Street.

HOUSE NO. 1558, LAMBSTOWN, TEMPLETOWN E.D.

Applications from John Waters "Conna", and John Waters "56, Conna". The history of this case was outlined and the Committee were informed that another house (i.e. No. 1463, Battlestown, Rathroe E.D. - formerly Tubbritt's) had now become available for re-letting. The Committee recommended that the applicant who had been living in the County at the date of his application be given the option on which house he desired and that the other house be offered to the second applicant.

LAURENCE CAHILL, CLONMINES, WELLINGTONBRIDGE:

(Applicant for new cottage). It was recommended that Mr. Cahill be listed for one of the two houses on the site at Curraghmore.

THOMAS FITZSIMONS, COOL, CAMPILE:

The Committee recommended that a tender be again sought for the building of a house on Site No. 4749, Monachee, Rathroe.

HOUSE NO. 2635, AUGHERMON, BALLYMITTY (TENANT/PURCHASER WALTER MORAN)

The Committee was informed that the County Manager was not prepared to give consent to the sale of this vested cottage to a Merchant for occupation by one of his employees.

VESTED HOUSE NO. 4408, BALLYFRORY, BANNOW E.D. (Nicholas Bennet)

The Committee was informed that the County Manager is proceeding for the recovery of possession of this house on the grounds of non-payment of annuity.
