A recognised driving licence is a driving licence issued in a member state of the European Union or of the European Economic Area, or a State declared to be a "recognised State" under the Road Traffic (Licensing of Drivers) Regulations, 1999.

All recognised licences presented for exchange purposes must either be current, **OR**:-

(a) in the case of licences issued by a member state of the European Union or of the European Economic Area, have expired within the ten year period preceding the date of licence exchange application,
